



## MESSING UP GOD'S PLAN FOR YOU

In this video, we discuss whether we can mess up God's plan for our life. The short answer is yes and no. God is infinite and bigger than any mistake we can make. But also, He's not.

### INTRODUCTION (00:00)

We can sin, make mistakes, and fail not because God isn't powerful. It's because we are not letting Him be powerful in our life — these happen out of our unwillingness to be led by the Holy Spirit.

1. *What areas of your life do you rarely think about consulting God's opinion?*
2. *Are there any times in your life when you didn't consult God's opinion on a matter? How did this work out for you (or those around you)?*

### CONSEQUENCES & REDEMPTION (02:57)

While we may sin, make mistakes, or fail and ruin a plan may have for our life, our repentance and trust in God will bring about His redemption.

3. *What consequences (both good or bad) have you had to live with as a result of choices (both healthy or unhealthy) you've made?*
4. *How has God redeemed (healed, restored, fixed, or replaced) a sin, failure, or mistake in your life?*

### HOW DO WE MOVE FORWARD (05:49)

Moving forward from our sins, failures, or mistakes requires us to repent and receive the Father's forgiveness. We also need to speak to the Holy Spirit about our situation and listen for His response. Finally, worship and release your situation to God and ask Him what He desires to give you in return.

5. *How have you seen repentance and release work out in yours or someone else's life?*

### ACTIVATION (09:08)

- 1) Repent and receive the Father's forgiveness for any wrongdoing on your part for the sin, failure, or mistake.
- 2) Speak to Him and actively listen for His response.
- 3) Worship and release any mistake, failure, or sin to God and receive His redemption.
